

A DAY IN OXFORD WITH A VISIT TO THE 600 YEAR OLD BODLEIAN LIBRARY

We will leave early morning where we arrive in Oxford to start our visit with a guided tour of the Bodleian Library. The library is one of the oldest libraries in the UK and is actually a series of interconnected buildings. It was founded in 1602 by Sir Thomas Bodley and is the main research library for the University of Oxford. During our tour we will see the Divinity School, Duke Humfrey's Library, Convocation House and the Chancellor's Court. At the end of our tour, you will have time to wander around Oxford town itself and explore many of the sites the town has to offer and of course visit the many coffee shops and eateries before returning home at the end of an enjoyable day.
