

SCOTNEY CASTLE

LAMBERHURST

We depart in the morning for the drive to Scotney Castle near Lamberhurst, Kent, where we shall have time to visit the House and Gardens. The medieval moated Old Scotney Castle lies in a peaceful wooded valley. In the 19th Century its owner, Edward Hussey III set about building a new house, partially demolishing the Old Castle to create a romantic folly, the centrepiece of his picturesque landscape. The gardens are often described as one of the most romantic gardens in the UK with the cloud-like planting of rhododendrons and azaleas.
