Waddesdon Manor is surrounded by the views of Oxfordshire and the Chiltern Hills and was built in the French Renaissance style of Louis XIV in the village of Waddesdon, Buckinghamshire by the Baron Ferdinand de Rothschild in 1874. The house now boasts an extensive art collection together with sculptures and immaculate furnishings. The collection has been added to by successive members of the Rothschild dynasty and includes Dutch masters and works by Reynolds and Gainsborough. The house has exceptional architecture together with the beautiful landscaped gardens it is an ideal place to explore and enjoy.
