

# CAPEL LE FERNE & HAWKINGE BATTLE OF BRITAIN MUSEUM

Our visit to Capel Le Ferne is a Memorial to the men of the Battle of Britain alongside a modern centre that brings to life the victory 'the Few' achieved over the Luftwaffe in 1940. It is a quiet place of pilgrimage together with an interactive visitor centre and there are the fantastic views over The Channel from the Spitfire Café. From here we move on to Hawkinge museum which is the oldest and has the largest collection of Battle of Britain artefacts in the country. The museum is on the site of the former RAF Hawkinge and the area was known as Hell Fire corner and despite the passage of time visitors can still savour the atmosphere of the airfields' past and the part it played in WWII.
