

BASILDON PARK HOUSE & GARDENS

Basildon Park lies south of Goring and Streatley and is northwest of Pangbourne above the south bank of the River Thames. This 18th-century Bath-stone house was inspired by Italian Palladian architecture. It was saved and lovingly restored by Lord and Lady Iliffe in the 1950s, who brought Basildon Park back to life by acquiring a collection of fine furnishings and selected Old Masters. Explore the richly decorated Neo-classical Hall, a spectacular staircase with cantilevered stairs and arched first-floor gallery and an octagonal drawing room with heavily gilded ceilings. Today the house is very popular as a film location and many classics have been filmed here. The gardens have been restored and beautifully laid out and there are many lovely views to take in from the terraces.
