

# BLenheim PALACE

Blenheim Palace situated in Woodstock not far from Oxford, is home to the 12th Duke and Duchess of Marlborough and was the birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill. It is a masterpiece of Baroque architecture with over 300 years of history to discover and is a World Heritage site set in over 2000 acres of park land which was landscaped by 'Capability' Brown. The Palace itself houses some of the finest collections of antique furniture in Europe and many art treasures and offers a unique visitor's experience.
