Marwell Zoo is situated on a 140-acre site near Winchester, Hampshire. The zoo was founded by Dr John Knowles and opened in 1972, and is now owned and run by the registered charity Marwell Wildlife. It is home to many exotic and endangered animals and was one of the earliest zoos in Europe to place emphasis on animal conservation. You can stroll around the outdoor areas and enjoy spotting the animals in their enclosures, these includes giraffes, white rhinos, Amur tigers, Humboldt penguins, Red Pandas, Snow Leopards and Zebras to name but a few. It is a lovely place to visit with friends and family. (Comfort stop enroute)
